# **The Senior Education & Training Plan**



At Oakey SHS, we ensure that students in Year 10 develop a Senior Education & Training or SET Plan in partnership with their parents/carers. The SET Plan is a key component of our school's career education program. It maps out a plan of action to put students on track for success in senior secondary, post-school education, and work.

During the SET planning process, students identify their Intended Learning Option (ILO) to be achieved through the compulsory participation phase. Students are supported to acquire the knowledge and skills to develop their SET Plan and to revise it during Years 11 and 12, particularly as their interests/goals change and if they find themselves off track.

Normally we invite students and parents/carers to an information evening that explores the following: the SET Planning process; the Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE); university pathways and the ATAR; additional support mechanisms to either extend students or support them to gain their QCE if the student finds themselves not on track; SATs or School-based Apprenticeships & Traineeships; and studying one or more subjects via distance education through the Brisbane School of Distance Education (BSDE).
